## A WORD FROM OUR MISSIONARIES



*Below is an excerpt from the Chapples' most recent newsletter. Please be in prayer for them while they are in Canada and for our brothers and sisters in Christ who live in Mexico.*

Well this update is definitely a bit late! The past month has been quite busy, and we have been struggling to keep our heads above the water. On May 28 we flew from Mexico to Ontario. Before leaving Mexico, we had a lot of personal stuff to get organized. ... Since we have returned to Canada, the political situation in Mexico has become quite unstable. You may have seen or heard about the rioting, deaths, and injuries in the city of Oaxaca ... The violence has spread to four or five other states, and the roads in many of those areas are nearly impassible. ... There were many places where the roads were blocked by fires and protesters. ... Thus far, the cities of Puebla and Mexico City (where we and the rest of our team live) have not had any problems, but the pastors are concerned that it may soon spread there. The unrest stems from new laws that have a big impact on school teachers and education.
