

Honduran Ministry

Melodie Francis is a missionary social worker in the town of Siguatepeque in the country of Honduras.

There are an estimated 8,000 children living on the streets of Honduras. Because there isn't enough money to provide for them, many have been turned out by their families, while others have escaped abusive homes. Living on the street is a deadly game, as children often become victims of sexual predators and drug dealers; many die prematurely.

Melodie serves in Casa Hogar, a home for 42 children and teens who have been abandoned on the streets and given up by family who cannot raise them.

Opportunities in maintenance and development of the 6+ acres of land regularly occur for teams of 6-8 persons. There are also individual opportunities to assist with the oversight, educational assistance, and development of the children for those who have some command of Spanish.
