## Why Reach Out to Honduras?

In 2013, Honduras, a country of eight million people and roughly the size of Ohio or Virginia, had the highest murders in non-conflict zones in the world ... The city of San Pedro Sula is the murder capital city of the world ... Fifty-six percent of the population is under the age of 25. Since 1998, 9,881 minors under the age of 23 were murdered of which 767 occurred between January and October 2014. Femicide\* in the state has increased by 246 percent. In 2012, Doctor's Without Borders stated that Honduras has a "violence epidemic."
