Camps have gotten off to a quick start. Both St. Thomas complexes have many children attending and hearing the gospel. In Aylmer, we have contact with around 14 families and seem to be gaining momentum each week. While in the Aylmer complex, we've had two different residents come to tell us that they are praying for us as we run camps. One of them even shared that he has been praying for some time that some sort of gospel outreach would come to the complex. Many of you have also shared with me how you are praying for the interns and the volunteers at camps. It is a blessing to be lifted in prayer and encouraging to be able to see prayers being answered.

A new complex and many more campers than in previous years (40 more than last year!) is exciting but also brings increased financial need. This year we are again fundraising for our camp t-shirts (\$16 will give one child a shirt), to run an outreach BBQ/carnival in the complexes, and to purchase children's Bibles to give away to campers who do not already own one (\$30 will give one child a Bible). Any additional funds raised will be used to run a giveaway similar to the shoe drive we ran last year. The details will be determined by the amount of money raised.
