SERMON DISCUSSION/APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Read the list of virtues in Colossians 3:12-14 and reflect on your own life. Based on that list of six virtues, where are you struggling the most? Why is that? How can you grow in this area?
2. Kindness is defined as the rendering of moral goodness. What's one new act of kindness that you can do this week for someone else? How are you going to do it? When are you going to do it?
3. Define biblical humility. Do you struggle with humility? If so, why? How do you kill the sin of pride in your heart? What Bible verses can you use to combat the sin of pride and foster the virtue of humility?
4. Paul makes it clear at the end of verse 13 that we must forgive one another in the church. Forgiving a fellow member is not an option, but a command. Is there anyone in the church that you need to forgive? What's keeping you from forgiving them? According to this verse, where does the power to forgive come from?
5. Homework: If there is anyone in the church who really exemplifies any of the virtues in this passage, share that evidence of grace with them as a word of encouragement.
