SERMON

Text: Psalm 34		
Inscription and Context: 1 Samuel 21:10-22:2		
1.	The King's Invitation: Worship God in your Affliction (vv. 1-3)	
2.	The King's Testimony: Godly Sufferers Experience His blessings (vv. 4-10)	
3.	The King's Teaching: Suffer Affliction Reverently (vv. 11-18)	
4.	The King of Kings' Gospel: The LORD redeems All of His People's Affliction! (vv. 19-22)	

SERMON DISCUSSION/APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- 1. David wrote, "Many are the afflictions of the righteous" (v. 19) but he also called the afflicted saints to "magnify the LORD with me and let us exalt his name together!" (vv. 2-3). What are some reasons why we find it difficult to worship God in our affliction? How can regularly gathering with God's people help us to worship Him in spite of our afflictions?
- 2. In Christ, God has delivered us from all of our fears (v. 4), troubles (v. 6), and afflictions (v. 19). He has redeemed us from condemnation (v. 22). Is this true for you? If so, how does knowing this help you to worship God *in spite of* your afflictions?
- 3. Are you using your current affliction as a license to sin against God? How might you "turn from evil" (v. 14) and honour God in your current affliction?
- 4. "Affliction will slay the wicked, and those who hate the righteous will be condemned" (v. 21). How does God redeeming you from all of your affliction and condemnation create an evangelistic zeal in your heart for the suffering sinner? Are there any suffering sinners you know of that you could pray to God to open a door for you to serve them and preach the gospel to them?
