Children's Ministry

Kindergarten (JK to Grade 1) and Children's Sunday School (Grades 2 to 5) are dismissed partway through the service. Children must be registered at the Welcome Centre prior to the service.

ELDER INSTALLATION

Charge to the Elder

John Hood,

Having repented of sin and put your faith in Jesus Christ; Having been baptized and made a member of this local church; Having faithfully served this church in many capacities; Having prayed, studied, read, and grown in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus;

Having aspired to this office of elder, and having been approved and affirmed to that office after careful examination, both by the elders and all the members of Eastwood Baptist Church...

- Do you now promise:
- to serve the Lord with all humility (Acts 20:19);
- to preach repentance and faith in Christ alone (Acts 20:21);
- to willingly accept suffering, should God place you in a position where obedience requires it (Acts 20:23);
- to value the calling and gospel of Jesus Christ above your own life (Acts 20:24);
- to resist every temptation to shrink back from declaring the whole counsel of God (Acts 20:27);
- to pay careful attention to yourself and careful attention to the church as the blood-bought possession of Jesus Christ, and thus to care for her as His most valuable possession (Acts 20:28);
- to stay alert at your post, even willing to rebuke fellow elders who preach or teach any doctrine not found in God's word (Acts 20:31);
- to live as if "it is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35);
- to lead with a single-minded zeal for the glory of God (Romans 12:8);

- to willingly suffer for Jesus' sake hardship, physical torture, betrayal, inconvenience, exposure, disappointment, persecution, sovereign weakenings, calamities, and the daily pressures of concern for the church (2 Corinthians 11-12);
- to treasure Jesus above all else, including your wife, your children, your church, your ministry, your knowledge, and your self (Philippians 2:8);
- to train yourself in godliness (1 Timothy 4:6);
- to labour and strive with persistence in the work of this ministry (1 Timothy 4:10);
- to keep close watch on yourself and your doctrine (1 Timothy 4:16);
- to purse righteousness, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness, and gentleness (1 Timothy 6:11);
- to never quit, never give up, never swerve from, or slack off, in your effort to fulfill your ministry, not even when you are tired and suffering (1 Timothy 6:12);
- to despise the allure of riches in this world and to live for the eternal wealth of Christ's presence in heaven (1 Timothy 6:17);
- to guard with your co-elders the sacred deposit of the gospel entrusted to your care (1 Timothy 6:20);
- to not be ashamed of the gospel or the Saviour, regardless of the audience (2 Timothy 1:8);
- to flee youthful sins and run toward being a man of God who handles the word of truth accurately (2 Timothy 2:22);
- to avoid foolish and ignorant controversies that breed quarrels (2 Timothy 2:23);
- to be kind to everyone, patiently enduring evil and correcting the ungodly with gentleness (1 Timothy 2:24-25);
- to preach the word of God in season and out of season, reproving, rebuking, and exhorting with complete patience and teaching (2 Timothy 4:2);
- to lead a life worthy of emulation (Hebrews 13:7);

- to joyfully watch over the souls of this flock as one who will give an account to God for each of them (Hebrews 13:17);
- to always preach with the Day of God's strict judgment for teachers in mind (James 3:1);
- to pray believingly for the sick (James 5:13);
- and to willingly and eagerly shepherd God's flock that has been entrusted to you by Almighty God (1 Peter 5:1).

If, in the sight of God and these witnesses you set your heart to make this pledge, promising that when you fail, you will seek both forgiveness and restoration as soon as possible, then I call upon you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom to answer, "I do."

Charge to the Church

Do you, the members of Eastwood Baptist Church, commit:

- to obey John and your elders, and to submit to them, remembering that they are keeping watch over your souls as those who will have to give an account (Hebrews 13:17);
- to let him lead with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you (Hebrews 13:17);
- to pray for him, that God may open to him a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ that he may make it clear, as he ought to speak (Colossians 4:2);
- to pray that he finishes his course and the ministry that he has received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God (Acts 20).

If so, answer, "we do."

SERMON DISCUSSION/APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- 1. Is there anything in particular that stood out to you from the sermon?
- 2. In one sense, we are all called to be ministers of the word, but you cannot give what you do not have. How is your Bible reading going? Is your soul being fuelled by the Holy Scriptures? If not, what needs to change in your life?
- 3. Are there any irreverent, silly myths that are consuming your attention? If so, what is it and what kind of effect is it having on your soul?
- 4. Godliness means to be like Christ. In what ways do you resemble Christ the most? In what ways do you resemble Christ the least?
- 5. Reflect on your own life. Would you say that you work hard for the Lord? Give examples.
- 6. What are some ways you can be serving more and spending your energy for the good of the church and the glory of Christ?
- 7. Take some time to pray for pastor John and the rest of the elders.
