Children's Ministry

The gym will be open for fellowship and play following the morning service. There is no childcare provided during this time. So, please keep an eye on your children to ensure their safety.

- 1. Is there anything in particular that stood out to you from the sermon?
- 2. Which basic principle of missions challenged you the most? Why is that?
- 3. Are there places or people God is leading you to go to for the sake of the gospel, where you're hesitant to go? Why is that?
- 4. Jesus emphasized the importance of preaching the gospel and doing good works to care for the needy. As you think about your own gospel ministry, are you balanced in your approach to engaging the lost? Do you emphasize one over the other? What needs to change in your life in order to be more balanced in obeying the great commission?
- 5. Are you ever tempted to minister and serve for personal gain? What does that say about what's in your heart? How do you fight against this temptation, or how do you help another Christian fight against this temptation?
- 6. How do you know when it's time to "shake the dust off your feet" and walk away? Do you find this hard to do?
