SERMON DISCUSSION/APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Is there anything in particular that stood out to you from the sermon?
2. In one sentence, explain the main point of Psalm 62.
3. What is your natural inner reaction when you experience trouble and affliction (i.e., frantic, angry, anxious, impatient, etc.)? Based on your answer, what does the Bible say about your specific response?
4. What does it mean to silently wait for God? How do you practice silencing your soul and waiting for God alone?
5. It was clear that King David had a very personal relationship with God (he uses the word "my" 14 times in Psalm 62). Do you know God in this kind of an intimate and personal way? How would you describe your relationship with the Lord?
6. What are you prone to trust in times of trouble? What's the problem with trusting the things of this world? What are some attributes of God that help strengthen your faith?
