Children's Ministry

Kindergarten (JK to Grade 1) and Children's Sunday School (Grades 2 to 5) are dismissed partway through the service. Children must be registered at the Welcome Centre prior to the service.

The gym will be open for fellowship and play following the morning service. There is no childcare provided during this time. So, please keep an eye on your children to ensure their safety.

SERMON DISCUSSION/APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Is there anything in particular that stood out to you from the sermon?
2. In one sentence, explain the main point of Psalm 55.
3. Are there ways you sin or are tempted to sin when someone wrongs you and hurts you? How did David deal with his hurt?
4. Is there any bitterness you're personally bearing in your heart right now? How does this Psalm help you to deal with bitterness?
5. Think about what is true of Yahweh. Name a few of his attributes and character. Why is it important to remember God as he has revealed himself in his word? How does remembering God rightly help us when we feel burdened by the cares of this world?
