Kindergarten (JK to Grade 1) and Children's Sunday School (Grades 2 to 5) are dismissed partway through the service. Children must be registered at the Welcome Centre prior to the service.

There is a private room in the nursery for nursing mothers where you can listen to the service. If you'd like to use this room, please ask one of the nursery workers.

The gym will be open for fellowship and play following the morning service. There is no childcare provided during this time, so please keep an eye on your children to ensure their safety.

5. Does being a compassionate person mean you need to care for and relieve the suffering of every person whose need comes into your life? How do you strike the right balance between showing compassion and not burning out?
6. What does this passage teach us about discipleship?
7. On a scale of 1-10 (1 being the most apathetic and 10 being the most active), how would you rate your faithfulness in serving the Lord? Explain. In what ways can you grow to be more faithfully active? How do you actually grow in faithfulness? What has helped you in the past to put to death the sin of laziness and serve the Lord?
