Washrooms

Children's Ministry

Nursery (0-24 months) and Preschool (2s and 3s) are open before the service. Children can be signed in at their respective rooms opposite the washrooms. Kindergarten (JK to Grade 1) and Children's Sunday School (Grades 2 to 5) are dismissed partway through the service. Children must be registered at the Welcome Centre prior to the service.

Nursing Mothers' Room

There is a private room in the nursery for nursing mothers where you can listen to the service. If you'd like to use this room, please ask one of the nursery workers.

Gymnasium

The gym will be open for fellowship and play following the morning service. There is no childcare provided during this time, so please keep an eye on your children to ensure their safety.

SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Is there anything in particular that stood out to you from the sermon?
2. In your own words, what is the main point of this passage?
3. Psalm 36:5-6 highlights four attributes of God: his steadfast love, faithfulness, righteousness, and judgments. How would you define each of these attributes in your own words? Which one encouraged you the most, and why?
4. How would you describe your delight in God? In what ways are you taking refuge under his wings, feasting on the abundance of his house, drinking from the river of his delights, and walking in his light?
5. Psalm 36 ends by describing the ultimate fate of the wicked (v. 12). How does this truth give you hope? How should it shape the way you live and respond to the evil you see in the world?
