Washrooms

Children's Ministry

Nursery (0-24 months) and Preschool (2s and 3s) are open before the service. Children can be signed in at their respective rooms opposite the washrooms. Kindergarten (JK to Grade 1) and Children's Sunday School (Grades 2 to 5) are dismissed partway through the service. Children must be registered at the Welcome Centre prior to the service.

There is a private room in the nursery for nursing mothers where you can listen to the service. If you'd like to use this room, please ask one of the nursery workers.

The gym will be open for fellowship and play following the morning service. There is no childcare provided during this time, so please keep an eye on your children to ensure their safety.

4. Psalm 100 calls us to "serve the LORD with gladness" (v2). In what specific ways are you serving the Lord right now?
5. If you're not actively serving the Lord, what might be preventing you from doing so? If you are serving him, would you describe your service as glad and joyful? Why or why not?
6. When serving the Lord feels difficult or burdensome, how can we cultivate joy in serving Him? What truths from Psalm 100 help us do so?
