Washrooms

Children's Ministry

SERMON

Title: Resurrection Hope and Endless Pleasure

Text: Psalm 16

1. Dependence on God (1)
2. Loyalty to God (2-4)
3. Inheritance from God (5-7)
4. Hope in God (8-10)
5. Pleasures of God (11)

SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Is there anything in particular that stood out to you from the sermon?
2. In your own words, what is the main point of this passage?
3. When crisis or hardship comes, where are you most tempted to seek refuge? Why do you think that is? According to Psalm 16, what does it look like to take refuge in the Lord?
4. In verse 4, David refuses to participate in the worship of false gods. In what ways are you tempted toward idolatry? What competes for your ultimate love, trust, or satisfaction? How does Psalm 16 help you recognize and put those idols to death?
5. David rejoices in the "portion" and "lot" the Lord has given him (vv. 5-6). When you think about your own lot in life, what comes to mind? How does Psalm 16 reshape the way you view your circumstances and God's provision? What difference should that make?
6. Psalm 16 ultimately points to the resurrection of Christ and the hope of our own resurrection (Acts 2:25-32). How should the certainty of the resurrection shape your everyday life? What difference does it make in the way you face suffering, temptation, and death? What do we lose when we neglect to meditate on this hope?
7. Verse 11 declares that true joy is found in God's presence and that there are "pleasures forevermore" at his right hand. Where are you most tempted to seek lasting joy or satisfaction apart from God? How does this verse challenge and encourage you?
